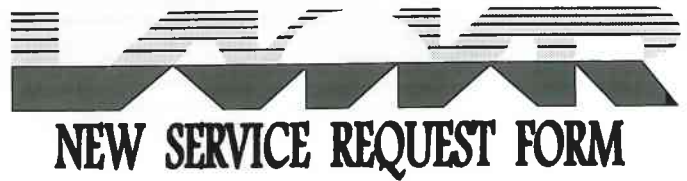

All requests for new service OR line extension involving construction activity are subject to a waiting period. Depending on the type of service and location, requests are filled in a chronological order (first come, first served basis). Connect orders, easements, deposits, agreements, and customer contribution forms must be completed and submitted to Lamar Utilities Board offices prior to beginning of construction.

Location of electric service entrance must be coordinated through this office at the beginning of construction, and upon completion of construction our engineering department should be notified. Customer is required to contact the City Of Lamar Billing Office at Main & Parmenter to ensure that the proper application is completed, applicable deposits are paid, and an order for connection is issued. Electric meters will be issued after the Colorado State Electrical Inspector has inspected and approved the installations.

Necessary and reasonable deviations from this form will be at the discretion of Lamar Utilities Board.
